



### Definitions

- learning streams – those areas covering student/teacher interaction (e.g. assignments, tasks) that can be identified in order to lighten the instructor's load.
- embedded skills – those skills that can be found within other activities (e.g. negotiations within marking) so that they can be utilized in order to promote critical thinking.
- micro-sensitivity – an awareness of learning streams within a curriculum/syllabus which can be exploited and/or replicated in order to lighten the instructor's load.

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
